Water & Wetlands Voluntary Assessment

The WSCGA Board of Directors is asking the membership to provide funds through a voluntary assessment to replenish the Restricted Account for Water and Wetlands. The fund is used to cover one-time expenses associated with issues that impact all growers such as litigation and public policy.

As we have updated growers, a lake owner group has failed in a suit against the DNR asking a Dane County court to require the DNR to do a number of things including defining runoff from cranberry marshes as a point source of pollution. If the plaintiffs had been successful in their effort, all growers would have been required to obtain discharge permits from the DNR similar to permits required of municipal and industrial waste treatment facilities.

The suggested rate is 2 cents per barrel of fruit sold. We appreciate your support of this critical fund.
