#### WSCGA Whole Farm Planning Incentive Program (WFPIP) For Nutrient Management

**Application period is June 1, 2010 through September 1, 2010.**

#### **Information and items to be included with your application.**

1. Completed application form.
2. Completed W-9 Form (*Request for Taxpayer Identification Number and Certification*).
3. Copy of Bed ID map with acreage amounts for each individual bed where nutrient management practices will be implemented. (i.e. "Exhibit A Map")
4. Once your original plan has been submitted and accepted you will be sent a WFPIP contract and appendix document for you to sign and return. By signing the contract document and appendix you are agreeing to implement and update your nutrient management plan on a yearly basis and WSCGA agrees to pay you a one-time cost-share rate of \$10/ac.
5. If the farm and/or tract numbers are not known please contact your local U.S. Department of Agriculture–Farm Service Agency office to inquire about your marsh farm records.
6. Establishing payment eligibility for USDA programs is **NOT** required.
